DTap - 5 doses
Tdap - 1 dose
Polio (OPV or IPV) - 4 doses
MMR - 2 doses
Hepatitis B - 3 doses
Hepatitis A - 2 doses
Varicella - 2 doses
MCV4 - 1 dose for Fr/Sr
2 doses for Sr.

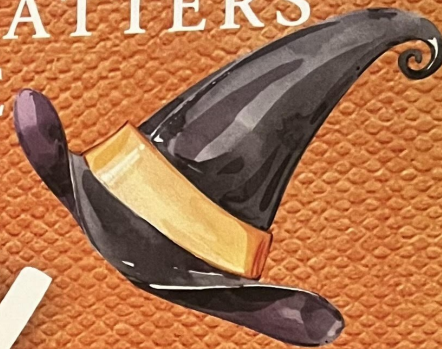
