<u>CENTRAL TURNABOUT INFORMATION:</u> Central's Turnabout Dance will be on Saturday, December 9th from 7:30 pm to 10:30 pm in the Central Commons. Turnabout is a semi-formal winter dance for students in grades 9 through 12. All Central students meeting the following criteria will be eligible to attend the dance.

- -Students must have passed 5 or more classes last grading period (GP 1)
- -Students must not have any out-school-suspension during the first semester
- -Students must have no more than 2 assignments to AEA (in-school suspension) during the first semester

Non-Central student guests must be pre-approved by the administration. Guests must either be a full-time traditional high school student who also meet the above criteria OR a recent high school graduate under the age of 21. Guest forms will be available outside of the athletic office and bookstore starting November 20th. Guest forms are due Thursday, December 7th.

All school rules apply during Turnabout, and appropriate attire is required. Tickets are \$20 per person and will be on sale in the bookstore on Monday, December 4th.
